COVID-19 Return to Competition Safety Rules and Procedures

Updated and effective from Saturday 26th September 2020

All persons attending the Club need to abide by the COVID Safety Procedures below.

1. Parking

Parking is now via Gate 2 (entry via East Street). We were previously parking through Gate 3 (Weeroona Road) but this gate is to remain locked at all times.

2. Hygiene Protocols

Everyone entering the venue MUST sanitise their hands at the stations provided.

3. Attendance Record

- a. **EVERYONE** who enters The Bruce Pryor Hockey Facility is required to have their attendance recorded in the sports hall reception. Failing to record your attendance will result in your immediate removal from the Facility.
- b. Do not enter the Bruce Pryor Facility if you or someone in your household is unwell, caring for person who is unwell, or under instruction from NSW Health to socially isolate. Please refer to www.health.nsw.gov.au for developing COVID updates.

4. Facility operation

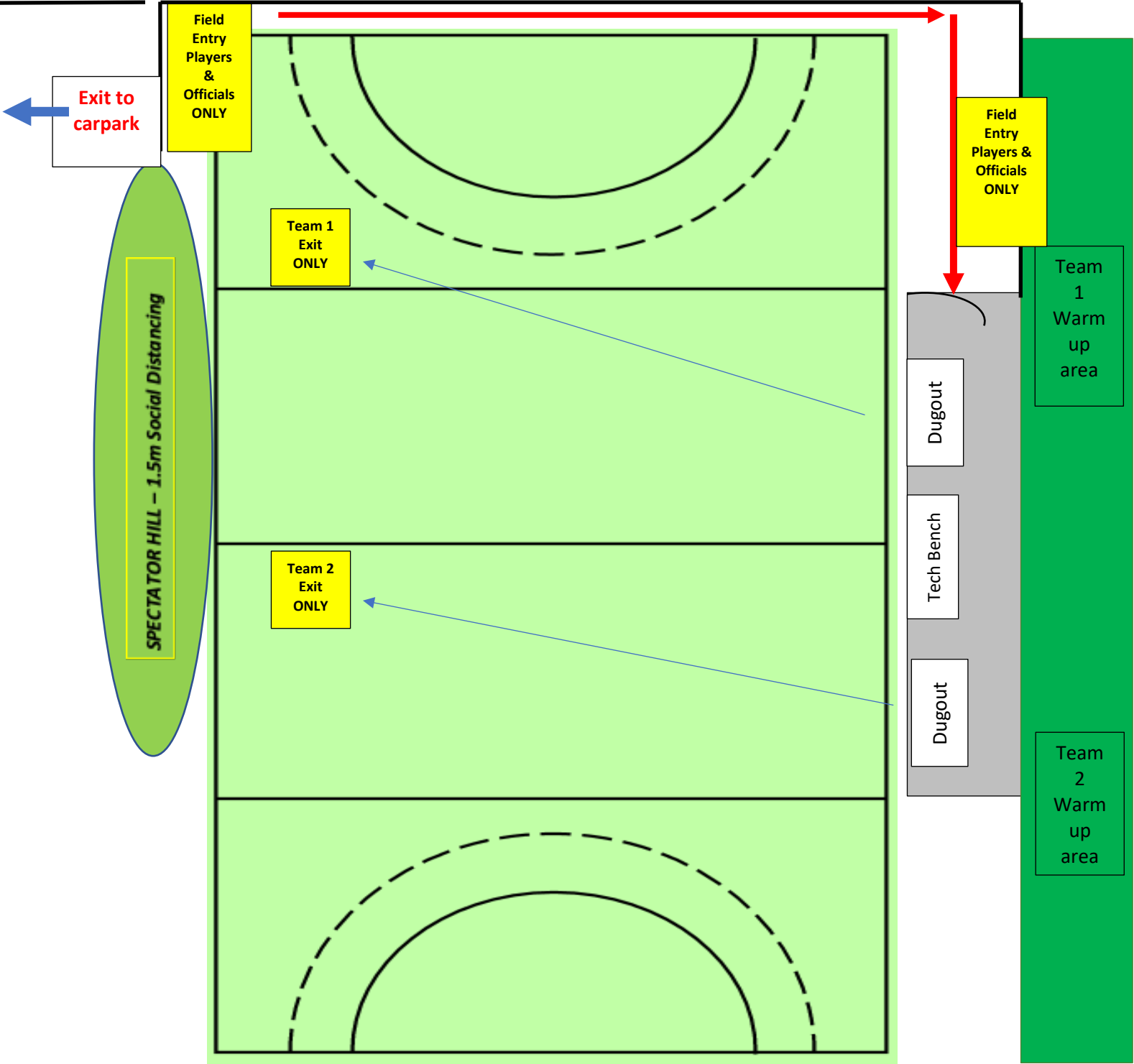
- Spectators are permitted to enter the Bruce Pryor Facility to watch the games, with a maximum capacity of 400 people at one time
- All spectators (parent/guardians) must maintain social distancing of 1.5m and provide their own seating
- Bathrooms located inside the Sports Hall. **No loitering permitted at any time**
- Follow the NSW Hockey guidelines of “get in, play, get out”. Arrive ready to play, leave promptly after games
- All teams to adhere to competition/Association COVID rules and regulations
- Teams are required to supply their own PPE and first aid kits
- Ice for injury is available in the Sports Hall
- Six hand sanitiser stations available for use
- Changerooms are closed
- No canteen available
- Isolation room available. Please refer to COVID-19 officer
- Observe all signage at the ground
- Obey any other direction from COVID-19 officer
- See map for field operations.

5. Dugouts and Field

- a. NO SPITTING or BUSHMAN BLOWS – this will lead to immediate removal from the facility
- b. Maintain social distancing in dugouts. No chairs available - standing room only
- c. NO team huddles in dugouts
- d. Bubblers for refill of water bottles only. No drinking directly from the fountain.
